



Mt. Mitake is 929m high and stands at the entrance to Chichibu-Tama-Kai National Park. The Musashi Mitake Shrine was built on the summit of this peak, which has been regarded as a sacred mountain since long ago. It is a prestigious mountain shrine with many myths and tales, and visitors can experience the feeling of being purified just by standing

and praying in front of the magnificent shrine. The spectacular view of the Kantō Plain from the grounds is also breathtaking.
