Canoe School Gravity also has a school in Lake Shiromaru of Okutama, and its beginner course (also offered for single participants) is popular. The lake is covered in mist from early summer to the fall, and visitors can enjoy the majestic atmosphere by taking part in early morning kayak tours.
