




Travel back in time

Kabutoya Ryokan | Hinoharamura

In this busy modern age, we sometimes long for that kind of slow life, coexisting with nature. In Tokyo Tama, there are still some

old Japanese houses with thatched roofs that offer accommodation and introduce the traditional way of life in the woodlands. Some such facilities include the Kabutoya Ryokan, Janoyu Onsen, where visitors can quietly enjoy their holidays, surrounded by beautiful nature.

Kabutoya Ryokan

This ryokan, or Japanese inn, was established 400 years ago, and its 200-year-old building is a wooden, 4-storey Kabuto style house with a hipped roof. The word "Kabuto" refers to a warrior's helmet. Their dishes use local ingredients. Guests can also enjoy a traditional Japanese atmosphere. Special accommodations available for Muslim guests.

Janoyu Onsen Takarasou

This accommodation facility was established over 300 years ago and the guesthouse is an impressive, Kabuto (warrior's helmet) style architecture.
