INFORMATION

About 40 min. Total length: 1.27 km

Go to Tama Station (IR Ome Line) and take the Nishi-Tokyo Bus towards Odake Nyudo, a 35-min trip. Get off at the last stop and walk for 5 min. (Weekends/Holidays: Higashi-nippara becomes the last stop, taking 30 min. before a 25-min. walk.)

7. KOBO DAISHI'S PLACE OF STUDY

The influential Buddhist monk is said to have trained here.

5. ENMUSUBI MATCHMAKING KANNON

The limestone cavern was a holy place for practitioners of Shugendo mountain worship. A Kannon statue is enshrined deep within the caves.

SAI RIVERBED

4. DEATH MOUNTAIN

This enormous underground cavern, with its otherworldly illumination, is the main attraction.

ENTRANCE

The cave is 11°C year-round, so bring insulated clothing.

3. SANZU RIVER

The Japanese Buddhist equivalent of the River Styx, and aptly named...



6. THE TWELVE YAKUSHI
Many one-ven coins have

been affixed to the wall here, like glittering stars.

8.KONGOZUE

The bunched-up stalagmites and stone pillars here are a sight to see.

Follow a straight road deep into Okutama's dense, towering mountains. At the end, a slight opening reveals the entrance to limestone caves.
