Kawagoedo Ryokuchi Old Folk House

Built in 1852 during the Kaei Period, Tachikawa is a large private house consisting of 6 rooms, which is unusual among the thatched private houses in Tokyo.

Muikara Private House

"Muikara" is the straw used for the rooves of old folk houses. A restored farmhouse building from the late Edo period is on display and you can see old-fashioned scenery such as fields and wells from the porch.

Old Shirasu House Buaiso

Buaiso, one of the last remaining thatched houses in Japan, was once the home of Jiro Shirasu and his wife Masako. Come gaze across the beautiful garden to the house with its display of the couple's collections.
