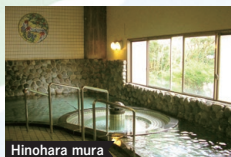


Okutama machi

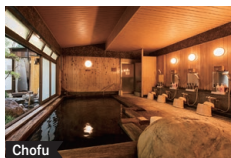


Hinohara mura

A public hot spring facility in a village that coexists with its surrounding rich nature. Many hikers and climbers visit as it is located in a mountainous area.

### Inagi Tennen Onsen / Tokino Irodori
