The Tama region is closely tied with some of Japan's leading animators such as Hayao Miyazaki and Kunio Okawara. There is also Studio Ghibli in Koganei and Tatsunoko Production in Musashino-shi, which makes the Tama region a core production area for globally famous "Japanimation".

Inagi City is currently promoting the "Kunio Okawara Project, and visitors to JR Inaginaganuma Station will find 3m tall statues of the RX-78-2 Gundam and Char's Zaku.
